Chambers of Commerce voice out on political uncertainty



Sri Lanka's Chambers of Commerce representing various industries - namely the Chamber of Construction Industry, the National Chamber of Industries, the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce, the Chamber of Young Lankan Entrepreneurs, the Federation of Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Sri Lanka, the Sri Lanka Apparel Exporters Association, the National Chamber of Commerce, and the National Chamber of Exporters – issued a joint statement regarding the political uncertainty that has gripped the country.

The statement is reproduced in full below.

“The undersigned, representing Chambers of Commerce are concerned that the current political uncertainty will result in many adverse consequences to the country, if it remains unresolved. We request the political authorities to resolve issues through the democratically established Institutions as early as possible. We appeal to the political Parties to ensure that law and order prevails, and that danger to the life and property of citizens is prevented. All parties should act in the best interests of our country, our people and the national economy.”
